It is important that you provide us with advance notice of your requirements so that we are able to tailor the programme appropriately and ensure that we are suitably prepared.

CHALLENGE BY CHOICE

We recognise that everyone has a different 'fear bubble' and it is our job to create a safe environment where everyone is able to 'stretch' and learn outside of their comfort zone (with the help of us and their team) but we do not coerce participants.

SAFETY

Our courses are equipped with modern safety systems to ensure that students are permanently clipped on and safe. All staff are trained to a high standard and CA provide all Personal Protective Equipment. We do not provide waterproofs, spare shoes, umbrellas etc. It is essential that students come prepared for the weather, as getting cold and wet will impact on the success of the day.



ORGANISING YOUR DAY

- Initial enquiry made to Challenge Academy. A member of staff advises what is on offer.
- Challenge Academy explains provision, customer guided on different programmes. Information pack sent by email.
- Customer makes booking, confirmation and invoice sent and customer enters contract with Challenge Academy as per terms of email sent.

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL DAY LOOK LIKE?

- Half Day lasts for 2hrs, Full Day minimum 4.5 hrs (including lunch).
- Lunch normally lasts for 30 minutes and can be eaten on-site. We have shelters for this purpose
- Start time normally 1000 or 1245. Arrive 15 mins prior to start.
- At the end of the day the senior facilitator/instructor will review the learning and celebrate success.
- Students divided into groups. Trip organisers can do this in advance.
- 'Join the Adventure'. We want teaching staff to get involved so we actively encourage participation.
- Groups will be led by Challenge Academy instructors throughout the day.
- We need to record our social impact and review your experience so will gather some data on the day and be in touch to get essential feedback shortly after your event.
- Activities include a combination of all activities on site, time permitting. Something for everyone.
